THIS CASE IS SET FOR HEARING ON Request for findings re: special immigrant juvenile status by guardians Sung Shin and David Won, aunt and uncle; minor Minji 16.

THE FOLLOWING ISSUES AND/OR DEFICIENCIES IN THE PAPERS ARE NOTED-

1. Sung Shin and David Won, aunt and uncle appointed guardians on 02/05/18, person only.
2. Guardians request that the court issue an order finding that minor is eligible for special immigrant juvenile status under the Special Immigrant Juvenile Status Statute (SIJS), 8 U.S.C., § 1101(a)(27)(J), which provides in relevant part as follows:
 - a. "The term 'special immigrant' means ... an immigrant who is present in the U.S.-
 - i. who has been declared dependent on a juvenile court located in the United States or whom such a court has legally committed to, or placed under the custody of, an agency or department of a State, or an individual or entity appointed by a State or juvenile court located in the United States, and whose reunification with 1 or both of the immigrant's parents is not viable due to abuse, neglect, abandonment, or a similar basis found under State law;
 - ii. for whom it has been determined in administrative or judicial proceedings that it would not be in the alien's best interest to be returned to the alien's or parent's previous country of nationality or country of last habitual residence; and
 - iii. in whose case the Secretary of Homeland Security consents to the grant of special immigrant juvenile status..."
3. The specific findings required under the statutory scheme would be: (1) that petitioner is an immigrant placed under the custody of an individual appointed by a state court (probate guardianship); (2) that petitioner's reunification with one or both parents is

not viable due to abandonment; and (3) it is not in the petitioner's best interest to be returned to his/her home country.

4. Once the above findings are made, petitioner may then begin the process with the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services to obtain legal permanent residence status. In other words, the findings requested are a prerequisite to filing a petition for a "green card."
5. State Superior Courts have jurisdiction to make factual findings of eligibility under SIJS See *N.O. v. Super. Ct. of Calif.*, County of Alameda, No. A122430 at 2-3 (Cal. Ct. App. 9/25/08). Thus, under the federal legislation, any superior court judge would have jurisdiction to hear the SIJS petition
6. Guardians offer a declaration in support of the requested findings stating, inter alia, the following:
 - a. Minor was born on 08/30/02 in Korea and lived there with minor's parents until August 2016.
 - b. Minor was allegedly neglected and abandoned by minor's parents.
 - c. Minor was forced to move to the United States as mother has stage four cancer.
 - d. Minor does not believe he/she can return to minor's parents because of parent's heavy involvement in the church, traveling and mother's cancer.

 - a. "The term 'special immigrant' means ... an immigrant who is present in the U.S. –
 - i. who has been declared dependent on a juvenile court located in the United States or whom such a court has legally committed to, or placed under the custody of, an agency or department of a State, or an individual or entity appointed by a State or juvenile court located in the United States, and whose reunification with 1 or both of the immigrant's parents is not viable due to abuse, neglect, abandonment, or a similar basis found under State law;
 - ii. for whom it has been determined in administrative or judicial proceedings that it would not be in the alien's best interest to be returned to the alien's or parent's previous country of nationality or country of last habitual residence; and
 - iii. in whose case the Secretary of Homeland Security consents to the grant of special immigrant juvenile status..."

 5. Petitioner, Flor Medina and former minor, Jessica Herrera, offer declarations in support of the requested findings stating, inter alia, the following:
 - a. Minor was born 10/20/98, in El Salvador and lived there with minor's mother until 2015.
 - b. Mother resides in El Salvador and has virtually given up all responsibilities toward the former minor as a result of the scars from the physical assault by the father, who is incarcerated now.
 - c. Both parents have abandoned their efforts to provide care and protection for Jessica. (see SJIS Petition, for specifics, LF p. 6 - 11).
 - d. Minor does not believe she can return to El Salvador as current conditions are not safe for her. Her direct encounter with violence has terrified her and both parents cannot provide any support or protection to her.
 6. Per the statutory scheme, this petition is to proceed only if guardianship of the minor is granted pursuant to the accompanying petition.

RECOMMENDATION

Court to reach only if accompanying guardianship petition is first granted. Court's discretion re factual findings that would support this petition.
