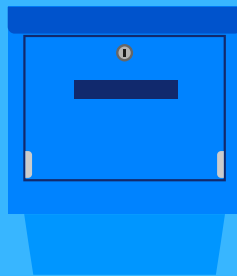
Reopening

Victorville Courthouse will open to the public Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Drop off box requirement



The public will be required to use the drop box for all filings except for ex parte, emergency matters, and CCP 170.1 and 170.6

Only litigants appearing on a case, filing an emergency or ex-parte document, attorneys, and law enforcement may enter the courthouse

June 1

Family Law and Countywide Bail Hearings



The Family Law courtrooms reopen hearing domestic violence permanent orders, request for order and same day, temporary restraining orders and ex-parte hearings.

Countywide bail video hearings will be relocated to Courtroom V10.

Criminal Courtrooms Reopen

Additional criminal courtrooms will reopen with modified calendars and staggered hearings held at 8:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m., and 1:30 p.m. Litigants will wait outside the courthouse with priority entrance until called in.
