18 A petition pursuant to Penal Code § 1170.95 is to be filed in the courthouse
19 where the sentencing took place. The Court Executive Office does not accept filings. If
20 the courthouse where sentencing took place no longer hears felony cases, then the
21 petition is to be filed in the courthouse that currently covers the court district in which
22 the original sentencing took place. For example, if sentencing took place in the Fontana
23 Courthouse, the petition is to be filed at the Rancho Cucamonga Courthouse; if
24 Barstow, the petition is to be filed at the Victorville Courthouse.

25 A judge who presided over the original sentencing will hear the petition, even if
26 he or she has been assigned to preside over a non-criminal calendar.

1 If the original sentencing judge is unavailable, pursuant to Rule of Court
2 10.603(d), I delegate my authority to designate another judge to rule on the petition to
3 the supervising judge of the criminal calendar or courthouse where the petition is filed.
