GENERAL ORDER OF THE
PRESIDING JUDGE

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17 In an effort to reduce judicial and clerical time, as well as prevent the
18 unnecessary use of resources of justice partner agencies when a Petition to Terminate
19 Sex Offender Registration is filed untimely pursuant to PC§290.5(a)(1), it is hereby
20 ordered that the Clerk's Office may reject petitions filed prematurely. The Court finds
21 that PC§290.5(a)(1) requires petitions to be filed on or after the petitioner's next
22 birthday after July 1, 2021 and any petition filed earlier is premature.

23 The Clerk's Office is ordered to verify the date of birth listed on the petition and,
24 if the underlying case was filed in San Bernardino County, by verifying case file records.
25 When rejecting a petition pursuant to this General Order, the Clerk shall provide a
26 rejection notice to Petitioner, and send notice to any Law Enforcement Agency and
27 District Attorney's office listed within the petition as having been served. If there is a
28 discrepancy between the petition and case file record regarding petitioner's date of

1 birth, the Clerk will accept the petition and forward it to a judicial officer for review and
2 direction.

3 This order is effective January 1, 2022, and supersedes all previous general
4 orders entitled *Rejection by Clerk of Petition to Terminate Sex Offender Registration*
5 *When Petition Filed Untimely Pursuant to PC§290.5(a)(1)* issued by previous Presiding
6 Judges. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2023,
