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18 Under California Rule of Court, Rule 3.1320(d), for good cause shown, a judge
19 may order the hearing of a demurrer to be held on an earlier or later date, on notice
20 prescribed by the judge.

21 When a party files a demurrer to an unlawful detainer case in any court of this
22 county, and the filing party requests a hearing date more than 10 calendar days from
23 the date of filing, the civil clerk shall submit the motion to the department that hears
24 unlawful detainer cases to determine if there is good cause to either hold the hearing on
25 an earlier or later date on notice prescribed by the court.
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1 The hearing date will then be determined by the unlawful detainer department
2 judicial officer, and shall be calendared accordingly.

3 This order is effective immediately and supersedes the general order entitled
4 *Showing Good Cause to Shorten the Time to Hear Demurrers in Unlawful Detainer*
5 *Cases*, signed on December 28, 2016, by Presiding Judge Haight III.
